

Installation of GNSS Radio:

1. Double click on the NtripGNSSInterentRadioWindows application. Follow the prompts for the installation.
2. Upon startup of the application, the following changes need to be made.
 - a. Tap on the Broadcaster box. For Host, add the address 198.202.228.109, hit the tab button, add port 2101, hit tab again.
 - b. The User ID is the ID you were given with your application as is the password. Remember these are case sensitive.
 - c. Move the pointer up to the Load box and select Load. This will save the settings you added.
 - d. Select OK.
3. From the main program window, tap on the Settings Box.
 - a. Tap on the TCP/IP bulls eye
 - b. Select the TCP/IP settings box – make sure port 2101 is added, say OK
 - c. Check the man.GGA box. Tap on set GGA. In the Latitude box add 34.00 and in the Longitude box add -81.00. Tap OK.
4. To exit the Settings Box tap OK.
5. Tap the START box. You should see streaming data pain above the Select Network box. If this happens, you have connected to the SC VRS and are receiving data. The network is operational.
