Recommendation #7 of the subject report suggests that Berkeley and Dorchester Counties coordinate their efforts to reconcile the County boundary line with the SC Geodetic Survey, as indicated. The problem is addressed in some detail at the top of page 15. The researchers allude to a discrepancy in the County boundary line between Berkeley and Dorchester Counties, from the Sawmill Branch to the Four Hole Swamp. Neither County is fully aware that this discrepancy exists. Would you please provide each County with a visual display of exactly what areas are in question and the overall impact this may have? Each County will have to evaluate the data provided and determine what course of action is best to pursue.
