- 1. Chairman Walldorf welcomed everyone to the meeting.
- 2. Meeting minutes for April 21, 2016 were adopted by the Board members.
- 3. Mr. Rainwater and Mr. Martin presented an overview, April revenues, and pending legislation. (See attached) ~Per Mr. Martin, six bills totaling \$12 million have already been signed by the Governor. Other legislation for FY17 is still undecided. There is a possible \$105 million in adjustments that may need to be made to next years' estimate, pending final approval by the General Assembly.
 - ~Mr. Rainwater addressed the Board, sharing that there would be no changes to the General Fund estimate, but that the Lottery estimate would be raised for this year and next year.
 - ~Chairman Walldorf asked the Members if there were any questions; there was no discussion or questions. Mr. Gower motioned that the estimate be adopted; Mr. Clyborne seconded and all voted aye.

There were no other questions or comments from the Members or Working Group.

With no further business pending, the meeting adjourned at 2:30pm. (Mr. Gower motioned, Mr. Clyborne seconded).
