- 1. Chairman Walldorf welcomed everyone to the meeting.
- 2. Frank Rainwater presented General Fund Revenue information.
 - ~Mr. Rainwater reviewed the General Fund revenue through July and August and discussed the estimate and how the major categories are performing.
- 3. Chad Walldorf moved to adopt the monitor and Emerson Gower seconded.
- 4. Robert Martin presented 5 major economic areas to focus on to prepare for the upcoming October meeting and the November estimate.
 - ~Robert Martin mentioned that the average rate of growth in the U.S. GDP since 2000 was just under 2% and is projected to remain fairly constant over the next few years. This is a good indicator for production in South Carolina.
 - ~Mr. Martin reviewed the recent growth rates in personal income for the state.
 - ~Mr. Martin emphasized that employment in the manufacturing industry has dropped off recently.
 - ~Core inflation has been around 1.5% for the past year.
 - ~The Federal Reserve met in September and left interest rates alone. The Fed will meet again in October and December.
 - ~There were no questions or comments from the Members or Working Group.
- 5. Frank Rainwater concluded the meeting with some words from Yogi Berra.
- 6. With no further business pending, Chad Walldorf motioned to adjourn the meeting. Emerson Gower seconded and the meeting adjourned at 2:30 pm.
