- 2. Frank Rainwater presented the Team Project overview. (See attached)
- 3. Rachael Fulmer presented information for the Strategic Planning team. (See attached) ~Mr. Clyborne mentioned that the wording of the Values statement was well chosen.
- 4. Gordon Shuford presented information for the Continuous Improvement team concerning RFA Legislation Changes and the Fiscal Impact Process. (See attached)
 - ~Mr. Gower asked how many states were reviewed for their Fiscal Impact processes. Mr. Shuford responded that "almost all" of the states were reviewed.

 - ~Mr. Rainwater mentioned that the goal of a new system is to print a bill, obtain information from SCEIS and input information back into SCEIS throughout the year. The process would also be cheaper in-house.

 - ~Mr. Rainwater mentioned that the Materials Management Office has assisted with this process. A bidding process was begun April 28th and was very competitive. Six bids were received, four were interviewed.
