
SOTERIA IT RISK ASSESSMENT

FY 2020-21 BUDGET PLAN

Recurring Operating Requests:

- Requesting additional *authorization* of \$15,308,315 for the SC Wireless 9-1-1 Program
 - Federal funds: \$2,308,315 (NG9-1-1 grant)
 - Other funds: \$13,000,000 (disbursement of funds transferred from the State Treasurer's Office)
- Requesting authorization for two additional other funded FTEs
 - No additional funds requested
 - Allows flexibility in funding used for filling vacancies and taking on additional contractual work

Proviso Changes:

- Delete Proviso 103.6 (NG9-1-1 Strategic Plan)
 - The amended Public Safety Communications Center Act allows RFA to use funds for any future strategic planning



EDUCATION FUNDING MODEL

EDUCATION FUNDING MODEL UPDATE

- Continued to gather additional data
 - Student teacher ratio and classroom size
 - Details on school facilities operating costs
 - Special Education cost and federal requirements
- Model to represent common set of educational cost
 - Focus on the needs of students, equity in allocation and costs to local tax base
 - Based on EFA, Other State Appropriations, Current Local expenditures
 - Match total number of teachers
 - Three categories Instruction, Facilities, District Services
- Align State appropriations and budgeting
 - Current state funding to determine state share
 - Propose realignment of state appropriations to match model
- Next Steps
 - Present model starting point on discussions
