AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE RESURVEY AND LOCATION OF THE BOUNDARY LINE BETWEEN THE COUNTIES OF KER-SHAW AND LANCASTER, IN THE STATE OF SOUTH CARO-LINA.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Boundary State of South Carolina, That the Governor is hereby author-Kershaw and ized and directed to appoint, within three months from the Lancaster to be resur-approval of this Act, three competent and disinterested surveyors, neither of whom shall be a resident of the County of Kershaw or Lancaster, which said surveyors shall survey, locate and designate, by proper marks, the boundary line between the Counties of Kershaw and Lancaster aforesaid. An agreement of a majority of said surveyors as to any matter of dispute shall settle the same.
