 Your dated the 7th of Dec^r
 A.D. 1762, I have measured
 and laid out into a Channel
 Awbery a plantation or tract of
 of a vacant land in Berkeley
 County, containing one hundred
 acres, in the fork between Broad
 and Saluda Rivers; And is
 situate lying and being on the
 N. side of Eggert River, and
 bounded on a branch of said
 river, known by the name of Peters
 Creek; And marks as the above plat represents. Certified under
 my hand this 19th day of January 1763. Edco. Hugrove, Esq
