All that certain tract or parcel of land, lying and being in Union and Newberry Counties, South Carolina, on the watershed of Enorse River, about six miles Southeast of Whitmire, being covered by the following grants:

This property is more particularly delineated on a map thereof, compiled by the U. S. Forest Service, Encree Purchase Unit, surveyed March, 1935, said map being hereby declared to be part and parcel of this description.

BEGINNING, at Corner 1, a point in center of old road, identified by P. P. Shouse as the corner, common to Jim McClurkin tract and Mrs. Carrie A. Shouse tract. A stone on edge of road is a witness to the corner. A scribed 3" persimmon bears S. 22° W., 0.12 chain distant and a scribed 6" oak bears N. 29° W.,

0.07 chain distant.

THENCE, in a Northeasterly direction, along and with the meanders of the center of old road, 17.0 chains to Corner 2, a point in the center of old road, common to Mrs. Carrie A. Shouse tract. A 6" fence post, on edge of road, is a witness to the corner.

THENCE, two (2) lines with Mrs. Carrie A. Shouse tract, S. 52° 45° E., 13.9 chains to Corner 3, a scribed 10" pine; N. 69° 09° E., 13.2 chains to Corner 4, a stake, set from calls, common to Mrs. Carrie A. Shouse tract and being the eighth corner of Blanche H. Cudd tract (58).

THENCE, four (4) lines with Tract 58, reversed,

S. 30° 22° E., 14.9 chains to Corner 5, a stake, set from calls;

N. 55° 30° E., 1.75 chains to Corner 6, a stake, set from calls;

S. 12° 22° W., 49.4 chains to Corner 7, a stake set at angle in hedgerow;

S. 5° 30° E., (crossing Newberry-Union County line), 32.4 chains to Corner 8, the fourth corner of Tract 58, also common to Dr. W. N. Glymph tract (291).

THENCE, three (3) lines with Tract 291,

- N. 64° 28' W., (crossing Newberry-Union County line), 31.4 chains to Corner 9, a stake set at angle in hedgerow;
- S. 51° 15' W., 6.8 chains to Corner 10, a stake set, identified

by P. P. Shouse as the corner;

S. 4° 04° E., 26.5 chains to Corner 11, a scribed 18" pine, common to Tract 291 and Mrs. Carrie A. Shouse tract.

THENCE, two (2) lines with Mrs. Carrie A. Shouse tract, S. 87° 58' W., 28.5 chains to Corner 12, a scribed 5" pine, near old road intersection;

S. 81° 20' W., 45.5 chains to Corner 13, a scribed 8" elm at angle in fence line, common to Mrs. Carrie A. Shouse tract and Jim McClurkin tract.

THENCE, three (3) lines with Jim McClurkin tract,
N. 44° 38' E., 99.5 chains to Corner 14, a stake set, old witness:

N. 0° 50' E., 18.8 chains to Corner 15, a stone and stake, old witnesses:

N. 8° 45° W., 23.2 chains to the PIACE OF BEGINNING, CONTAINING FIVE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE AND SEVEN-TENTHS (529.7) ACRES, BE THE SAME MORE OR IESS.

BEGINNING at Corner 1, a scribed 18" cak near old road, common to Mrs. Carrie A. Shouse tract. A scribed 8" pine bears N. 88° 15' E., 0.32 chain distant and a 7" cak bears S. 14° 30' W., 0.30 chain distant.

THENCE, with Mrs. Carrie A. Shouse tract,

N. 14° 42' W., 17.3 chains to Corner 2, a scribed 10" pine, common to Mrs. Carrie A. Shouse tract and J. D. Epps, Jr., tract.

THENCE, three (3) lines with J. D. Epps, Jr., tract, N. 62° 45' E., 10.3 chains to Corner 3, a stake set, identified by P. P. Shouse as the corner;

N. 11° 47° E., 12.8 chains to Corner 4, a stake set, identified by P. P. Shouse as the corner;

N. 63° 28° E., 31.0 chains to Corner 5, a stone, old witnesses, common to J. D. Epps, Jr., tract and E. F. Ratchford tract, (249).

THENCE, with Tract 249, reversed.

S. 18° 30° E., 5.2 chains to Corner 6, a stake set on hedgerow, the nineteenth corner of Tract 249 and the fourteenth corner of Blanche H. Cudd tract (58).

THENCE, three (3) lines with Tract 58, reversed,

- S. 31° 00' E., 16.9 chains to Corner 7, a stake set;
- S. 41° 38' W., 20.3 chains to Corner 8, a stake, a new stake set alongside;
- S. 67° 10' W., 25.7 chains to Corner 9, an 18" white oak, common to Tract 58 and Mrs. Carrie A. Shouse tract.

THENCE, with Mrs. Carrie A. Shouse tract,

S. 66° 28' W., 8.8 chains to the PLACE OF BEGINNING, CONTAINING ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FOUR AND NINE-TENTHS (124.9) ACRES, BE THE SAME MORE OR LESS.
