
KEY ECONOMIC AND FISCAL ISSUES AND ASSUMPTIONS FOR FY 2020-21

Key Issues – Final FY 2019-20

- Are final FY 2019-20 revenues the correct base for forecasting FY 2020-21 revenues
 - Surplus of \$xxx million
 - Federal Stimulus
 - Non-accrual of tax refunds
- Did the economy and revenue collections bottomout in the second quarter (April – June) of 2020? Have revenues stabilized, will they drop again, or will they increase?

Questions for FY 2020-21

- How much longer will social distancing continue to affect the economy?
 - Impact on economic activity
 - Impact on employment
 - Consumer Behavior (travel, dining out, Christmas)
- New Federal Stimulus Actions
 - Unemployment
 - Payroll Protection Program (ends Oct 1)
- Tax Year 2020 (April 2021) v Tax Year 2019
 - Loss of Business Income
 - Unemployment Compensation Taxable


