



### INTENT AND USAGE

Text blocks are the primary way of conveying verbal information to site visitors. Most pages will include at least one text block, but as they are very non-visual elements they should be used in conjunction with other more visual components such as call to actions, graphs, etc. General administration uses a rich text editor, providing the content manager the ability to apply formatting such as bold, italics, underlines, bulleted lists, header / subheader styles, hyperlinks, images, videos.

### INTENT AND USAGE

Bulletin blocks are multipurpose component blocks that allow SCRFA to highlight the information they would most like users to focus on, as well as serve a dual purpose of acting as a place that users can view any updates made to a specific section. This allows SCRFA to prioritize specific content regarding each section of their website, while also allowing users to view recent updates from one central place without SCRFA having to manually record updates every time they are entered.

### FIELDS

- Highlights (Section Title)
  - Item title (Link, file, or post)
  - Type of Link (attachment, external link, XLS, PP)
  - Date published
- Recent Updates (Section title)
  - May set up to six links of recently updated items for display
- Each link includes:
  - Date published
  - Link title (max length tbd)
  - Date updated

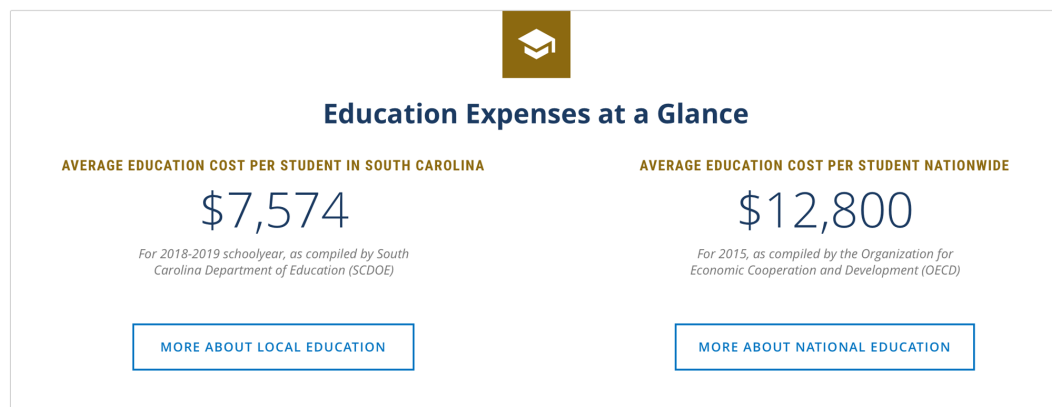

# Accordions

### INTENT AND USAGE

Accordions are well-suited for handling a large volume of content on a page without it becoming too visually overwhelming, especially when it can be classified some how such as into Q&A, FAQs, etc. Surfacing the title of a section only allows the user to navigate to (expand) sections of interest. Accordions allow users to easily scan past or skip content that does not interest them. This accommodates a limited number of 'levels' - just a parent (displayed section header) and child (content that displays when the section is opened).

### FIELDS

- A page's accordion component is made up of one to several accordion sections. Each section requires a section title and section content, where the content is specified via rich text editor (conceivably the content creator could use the rich text editor to put in an image or other media). Color theme options TBD.

### INTENT AND USAGE

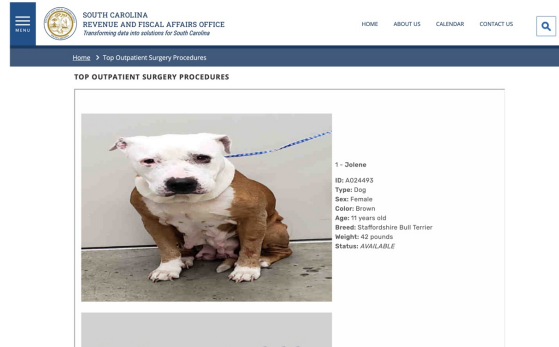
Embedded iframes should be used sparingly. They are especially useful in instances where an interactive feature is housed in a separate application. As you will see from examples below, embedding content in an iframe places the content on the page so that global elements including the header, footer, and breadcrumbs, are applied. The site's global styling is not applied to content in an iframe, so using these can create inconsistency in the user experience, which is why they should be used sparingly. If the information can be maintained directly in the CMS using native components, it is recommended you do that.

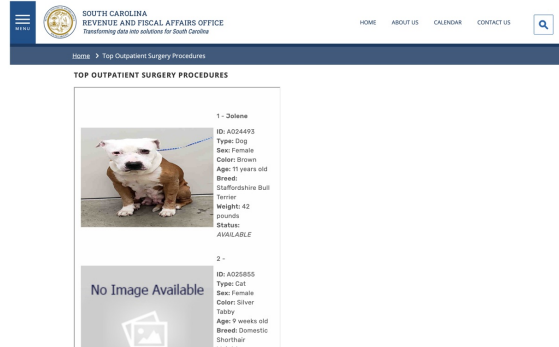

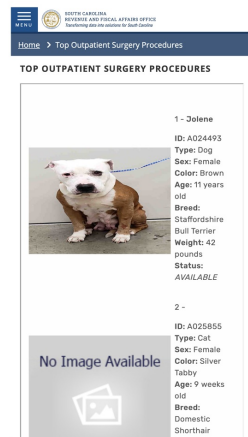
It is **recommended** embedded iframes are inserted into full width sections in order to allow for an adequate viewing experience for the user, and a likelihood that the source material will fit seamlessly into the website's layout builder.

#### Iframe at 50%



It is **not recommended** to use iframes at reduced section widths unless the original content is responsive or can easily be condensed without spilling off the page so as to avoid instances where an internal frame scroll is required on a reduced section container. Content best suited for partial width embedding are photo or visual heavy iframes, and iframes whose source content exhibits responsive behavior.

#### Iframe on Mobile Display



iframes rely on the original content's ability to resize for smaller devices. It is not recommended to use iframes if the original content is not mobile responsive.


