Cor Stake by the Commissioners Ascertained to be in Lat 35° 00' N^o

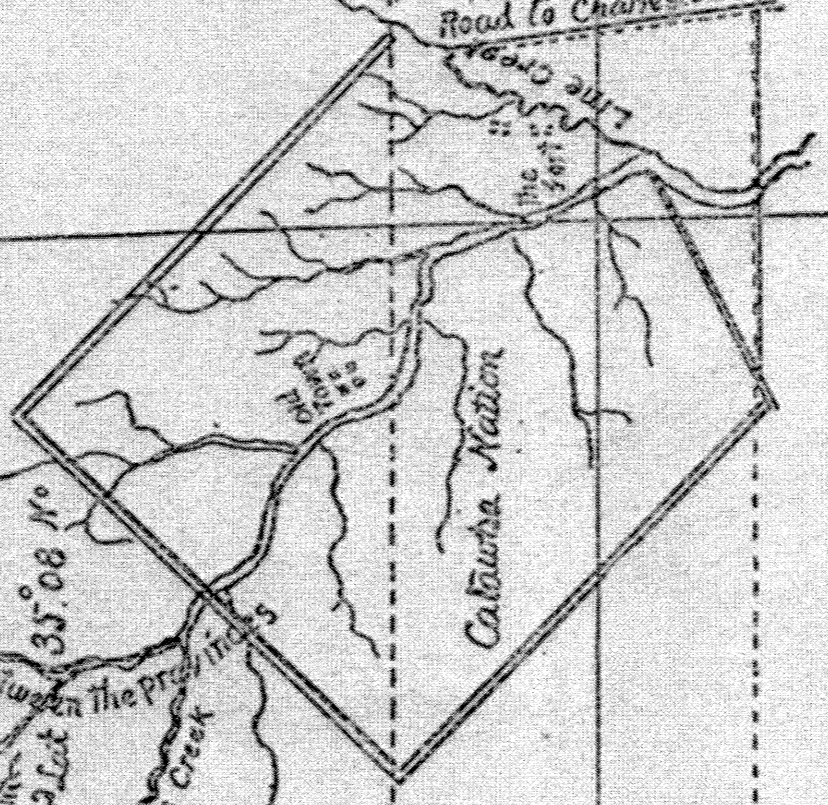
This line runs South East
