


General Fund – Actuals vs. Estimates


Revenues continue to grow faster than expected and are \$853.0 million above the estimate year-to-date

Actuals, Estimates, and Target Range, FY 2018-19 to FY 2021-22




Employment – Working EstimateWorking estimate in FY 2021-22 and FY 2022-23 considers faster than expected employment growth



SC Personal Income



Working estimates for FY 2021-22 and FY 2022-23 remain above the historical trend






Sales Tax - Actual vs. Working Estimate Working estimate projects a tapering in collections from the elevated levels in 2021
