Incorporated in 1831. Latitude 34° 34' N, Longitude 1° 5' 30" West from Col. S. E. Bearing from Col. N 43° W. 84 Miles. Reidville Chartered 1859 Cedar Spring Asylum organized 1849. Cars run to Spartanburg C. H. 1859 Nov 23. We further certify that in pursuance of a contract & instructions from the County Commissioners that there are twelve Townships, containing in the aggregate

square miles, having such form shape and boundaries as the red lines indicate & the red lined Rivers & creeks Survey closed in February 22nd 1869. By
