District Info is a tool designed to provide information related to the various districts associated with a South Carolina address or point on the map. Below is a quick reference guide to assist you.

GETTING STARTED

Search a South Carolina address using one of the following search methods:

- Enter an address in the search box
- Select *Use current location*
- Click a point within the map

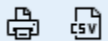
Enter a South Carolina address in the search bar as shown below.

 - Council of Government (COG)
 - 2020 Census Population

Users may also view 2020 Aerial Imagery captured and maintained by the SC Aerial Photography Program.





Use:

The  Home button to zoom back to the statewide scale,

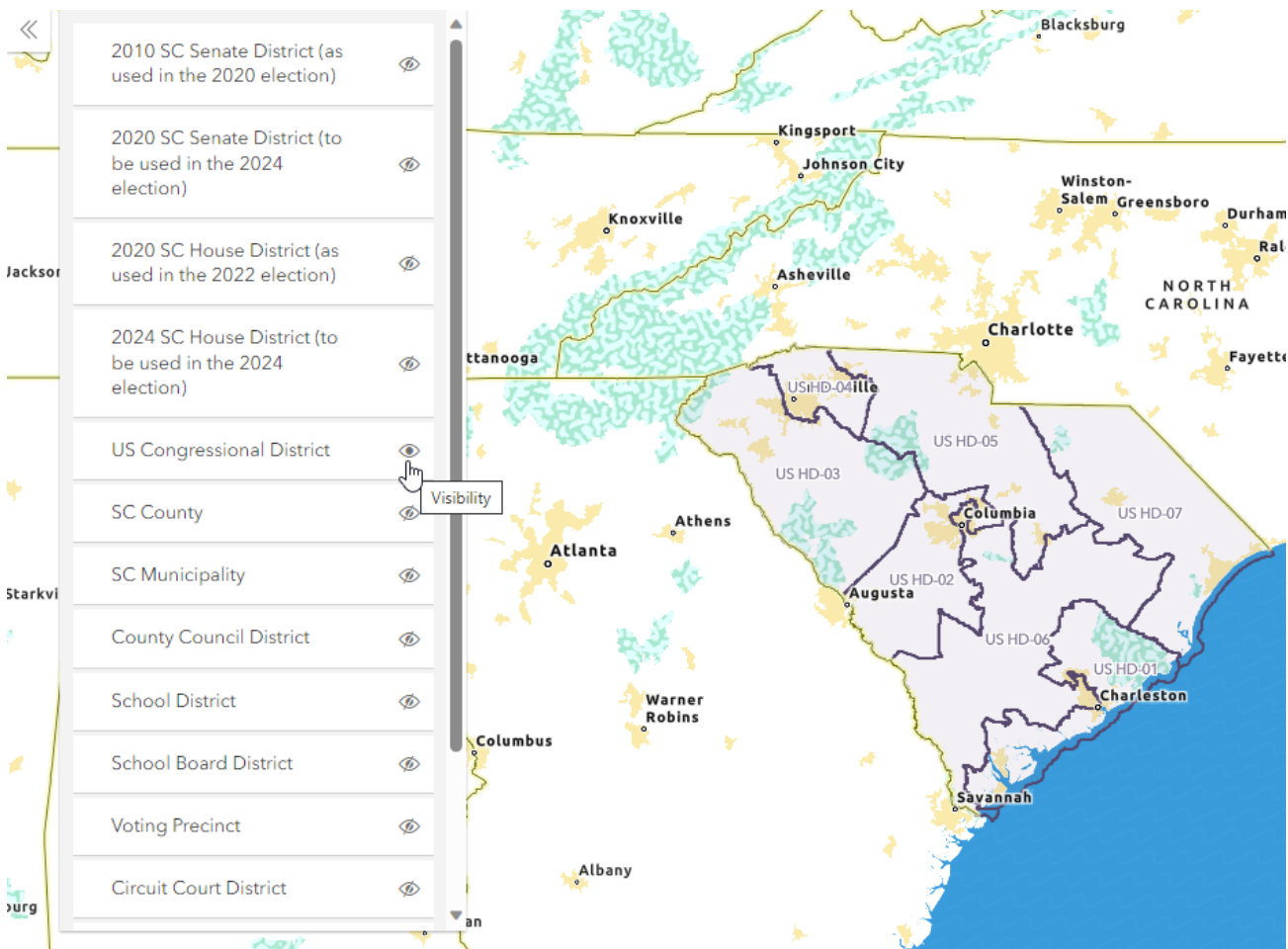
The  Current Location button to search an address in your current location,

The  + and - buttons to zoom in/out of the map.

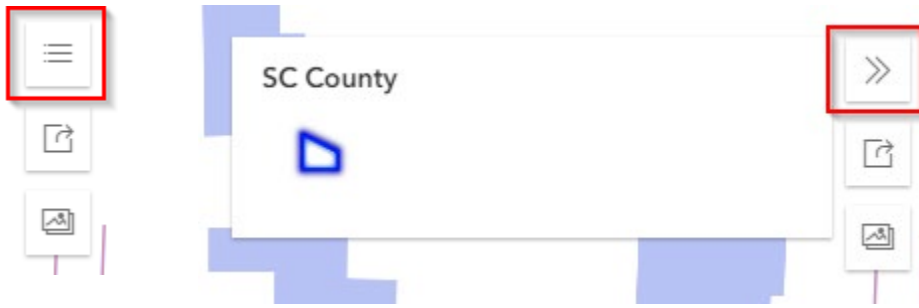
The default view of the map shows the SC counties and a basemap (background map).

 To show other district layers on the map, use the Layers button to see available districts and turn them on/off.

As shown in the image below, click the eye buttons on/off to turn map layers on/off.

Basemaps



When first opening the app, District Info uses the Enhanced Contrast Map, a web map that provides a detailed vector basemap using enhanced contrast and a color-vision-deficient-safe palette. This basemap is designed to meet the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) Strong Accessibility (AA) standard, and US Government Section 508 compliance.



By clicking the 'Toggle Basemap' button, users can switch to the Open Street Map Light Gray Canvas basemap, which is a more simplified background map.
