RESOLUTION APPOINTING COMMISSIONERS TO RUN THE DIVIDING LINE BETWEEN RICHLAND AND FAIRFIELD DISTRICTS. (2 PAGES)

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1818-8-01 In the Senate Sept 9th 1818
Whereas The Line of Division Between the District of
Richland and the District of Fairfield has never been
Marked from the head of Roundtop to Little River
As Established by Act of Assembly And Whereas Great-
Inconvenience May arise from the uncertainty thereby
occasioned - Resolved that John Byrum Esquire of Richland and
William
Hester and Samuel C. Hester Esquires on the part of Fairfield
be and they are hereby appointed Commissioners to run out
and Mark the said Line of Division from the head of Roundtop
to Little River near the plantation of Phillip Shaver and that
they do run and Mark the said Line as nearly as they can
Possibly ascertain When the former Line was run by
Tobias Canty and that they be empowered to employ their
Carriers and Axemen to assist them and that they Return a fair
and Descriptive plat thereof to the Legislature.

Ordered that it be sent to the
House of Representatives for their Concur-
rence.

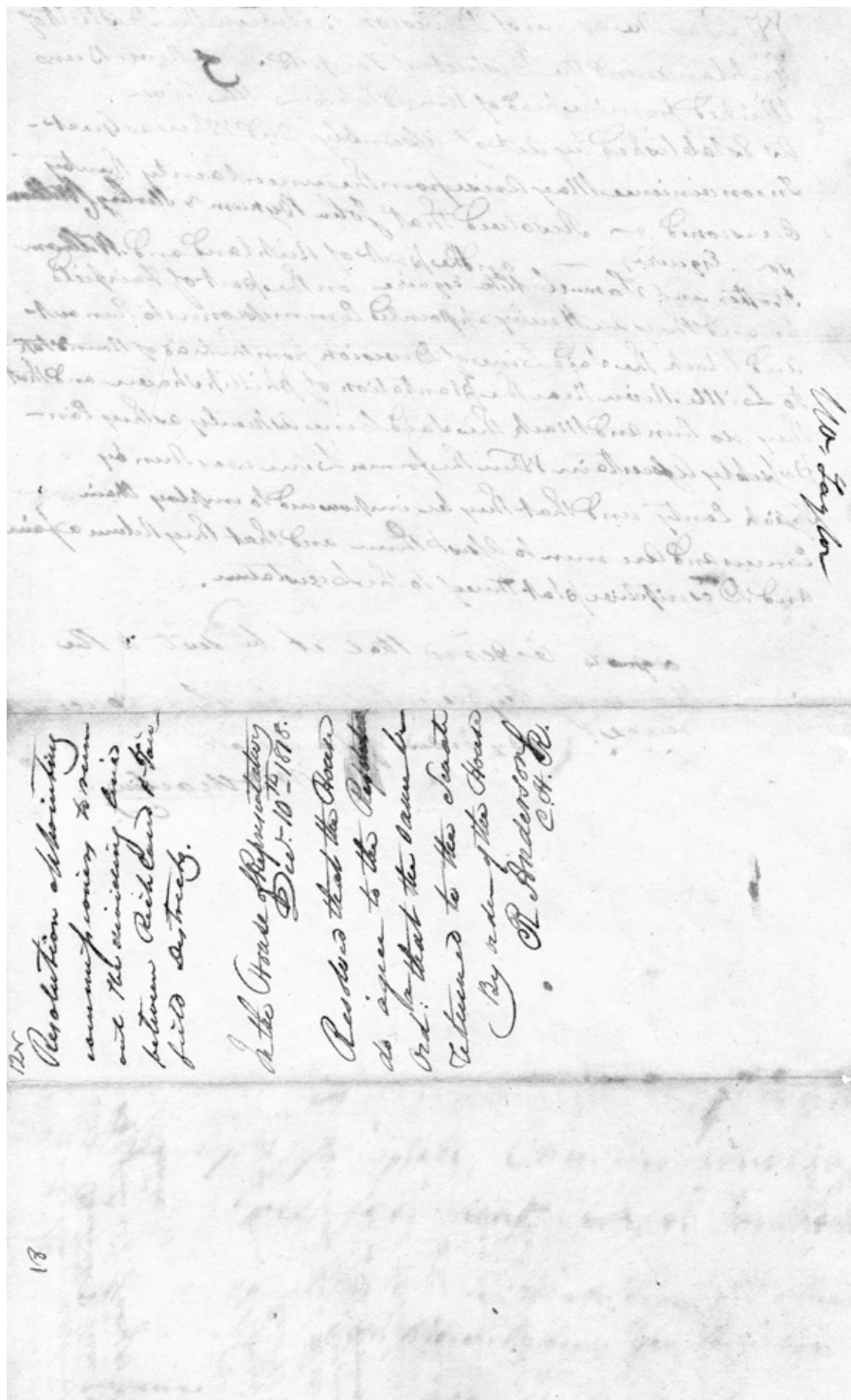
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
