

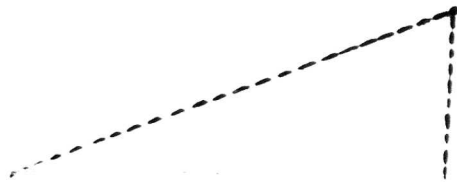

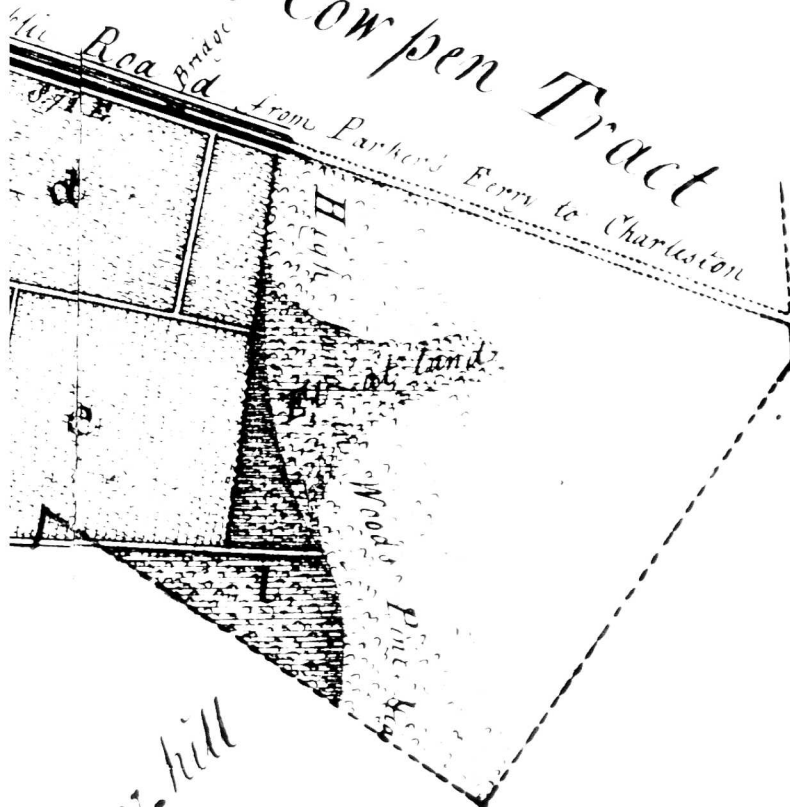

# Drayton's Cowpen Tract



This Plan exhibits the shape and form of the Swamp or Rice land on that part of Drayton's Cowpen Tract lying South of the Public Road leading from Charleston to Parker's Ferry lately purchased by William Washington Esq. — Showing the Knolls in it.

The Swamp or Rice land is found to contain 130 Acres 9 tenths, including drains, ditches, banks &c. and the Knolls of high and flat lands in woods 20 Acres 7 tenths — From a Survey taken in May 1790
