AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE RESURVEY AND LOCATION OF THE BOUNDARY LINE BETWEEN THE COUNTIES OF KERSHAW AND LANCASTER, IN THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA.

Boundary line between Kershaw and Lancaster to be resurveyed. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted* by the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina, That the Governor is hereby authorized and directed to appoint, within three months from the approval of this Act, three competent and disinterested surveyors, neither of whom shall be a resident of the County of Kershaw or Lancaster, which said surveyors shall survey, locate and designate, by proper marks, the boundary line between the Counties of Kershaw and Lancaster aforesaid. An agreement of a majority of said surveyors as to any matter of dispute shall settle the same.

Surveyors to make report. SEC. 2. That the surveyors so appointed shall proceed to make said survey and report in writing to the Governor the result of their work, together with a plat of the line so located and the reasons for so locating the said line, which said report shall be made to the Governor and by him submitted to the General Assembly at its next session hereafter.

SEC. 3. That the expenses of said survey shall be paid in equal proportions by the Counties of Kershaw and Lancaster out of any ordinary County funds.

SEC. 4. That all Acts or parts of Acts in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 1 OF AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4 OF AN ACT ENTITLED 'AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A NEW SCHOOL DISTRICT IN SPARTANBURG COUNTY, AND TO AUTHORIZE THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF A LOCAL TAX THEREIN,' APPROVED DECEMBER 22, 1883," APPROVED 15TH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1901, EMPOWERING THE TRUSTEES TO REGULATE THE CHARGES FOR NON-RESIDENT CHILDREN.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted* by the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina, That Section 1 of an Act entitled Act 15 Feb., 1901, in regard to new school district in Spartanburg County, amended. "An Act to amend Section 4 of an Act entitled 'An Act to provide for the establishment of a new School District in Spartanburg County, and to authorize the levy and collection of a local tax therein,' approved December 22, 1883," approved 15th day of February, 1901, be, and the same is hereby, amended by adding at the end of said Section 1 the following: "Nothing in this Act shall be construed to prevent the collection of tuition fees from pupils resident outside the limits of the said School District who may attend the Spartanburg schools; but the Trustees shall have power to fix, assess and collect all charges deemed by them proper from non-resident children, or children of non-resident parents, who may attend said schools;" so that said Section 1, when thus amended, shall read as follows:

Section 1. That Section 4 of an Act entitled "An Act to provide for the establishment of a new School District in Spartanburg County, and to authorize the levy and collection of a local tax therein," approved December 22, 1883, be amended so as to read as follows:

Section 4. That when the persons answering the above description shall have assembled in public meeting, they shall have power: First. To select a Chairman and Secretary, adjourn from time to time, decide what additional tax, if any, shall be levied, and appropriate the same in such manner as they may think best for the educational interests of said School District: *Provided*, That no tax thus levied shall be repealed at any subsequent meeting within the same year.
