**BILL SUMMARY:**

This Bill would amend Sections 17-22-50 and 17-22-60 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by allowing a person to participate in the pre-trial intervention program more than once with the solicitor's consent.

The South Carolina Commission on Prosecution Coordination indicates that there would be no impact on the General Fund. Pretrial intervention programs are funded through the application and participation fees.
