BILL SUMMARY:

House Bill 3143 amends Title 45, 27 and 15 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by adding Section 45-1-15, Section 27-40-445 and Section 15-75-70 relating to notification of prior bedbug infestations at transient or resident facilities. The Bill provides that the manager of any such facility shall conspicuously post a notice of bedbug infestation in any (guest) room in which there has been a prior bedbug infestation.

EXPLANATION OF IMPACT:

Department of Health & Environmental Control (DHEC)

The Department reports that the facilities referenced in this Bill are not regulated by DHEC. Therefore, this Bill would have no cost impact on the agency.
