BILL SUMMARY:

House Bill 3345 amends the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by adding Article 3, to Chapter 2 of Title 56 which creates provisions that oversee the registration of Mopeds. The Bill also amends various other Sections of Law with the definition of the term "Moped" or the substitution of the term "Moped" for other terms currently used in the Laws.

EXPLANATION OF IMPACT:

The Department of Motor Vehicles indicates that this Bill will have a minimal impact on the General Fund of the State, which the agency can absorb at their current level of funding.
