BILL SUMMARY:

House Bill 3382 amends the 1976 South Carolina Code of Laws by adding Section 53-5-65 so as to provide that Veteran's Day, Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, and Memorial Day must be recognized as holidays for all local school districts of the State and that the schools and districts offices must be closed on those dates.

EXPLANATION OF IMPACT:

The South Carolina Department of Education (SCDE) indicates this Bill will have no fiscal impact on the General Fund of the State or on Federal and/or Other Funds.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT IMPACT:

SCDE indicates the fiscal impact to local government would be minimal. The Bill reduces school district flexibility when creating their school calendars.
