BILL SUMMARY:

House Bill 3567 amends Section 44-7-130(18) of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by revising the definition of “children and adolescents in need of mental health treatment” in a residential treatment facility so as to increase the age of eligibility from “under eighteen” to “under twenty-one” years of age.
