Explanation of Fiscal Impact

State Expenditure

This bill adds Section 40-29-327, which states that each manufactured housing retail dealer location must have one authorized official representing the dealership, an authorized official who is not the dealer must hold a manufactured home retail salesperson or retail dealer license, and the Manufactured Housing Board must be notified in writing within twenty days if the authorized official changes.

The Department of Labor, Licensing and Regulation reports that this bill would have no expenditure impact on the General Fund, Federal Funds, or Other Funds.
