BILL SUMMARY:

House Bill 3906 amends Section 12-10-85(B) of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to the Rural Infrastructure Fund administered by the Department of Commerce. The Bill adds the guideline that Fund grants must be available to counties with a population of less than 40,000 and to municipalities located in a county with a population of less than 40,000.
