Fiscal Impact Summary

This bill will have no expenditure impact on the Department of Health and Environmental Control (DHEC) because the agency will be able to accomplish the duties enumerated in this bill using its existing appropriations and staff.

Explanation of Fiscal Impact

Introduced on April 6, 2021

State Expenditure

This bill requires a community residential care facility to have a certain ratio of staff members or direct care volunteers to residents, depending on whether it is during peak or nonpeak hours. This condition is a requirement for the facility's licensure. Additionally, the bill requires video cameras to be installed at all entrances, exits, and common areas of an assisted living center or other community residential care facility. Assisted living centers and other community residential care facilities are licensed by DHEC. The department shall establish a system for maintaining the recorded images produced by continuous video monitoring. DHEC reports that the agency will be able to accomplish the duties enumerated in this bill using its existing appropriations and staff. Therefore, there is no expenditure impact on the department.
