Explanation of Fiscal Impact

Explanation of Amendment by the House of Representatives on March 2, 2016

State Expenditure

The amended bill increases the number of annual training hours for an operator of a family childcare home and anyone who is employed by or contracts with an operator of a family childcare home. A minimum of ten hours of training approved by the department is required beginning July 1, 2017. The amended bill also requires the department to provide written notice of withdrawal or denial by certified registered mail.

The Department of Social Services indicates that the amended bill will have no expenditure impact to the General Fund, Federal Funds, or Other Funds.

Explanation of Bill Filed May 26, 2015

State Expenditure

This bill increases the number of training hours for family childcare home operators and employees from two to ten hours. It also gives additional authority to the Department of Social Services to renew or deny statements of registration for family childcare homes for placing children at risk, over-enrollment, or failing to meet training requirements.

The Department of Social Services indicates that this bill will have no expenditure impact on the General Fund, Federal Funds, or Other Funds.
