BILL SUMMARY:

House Bill 4384 amends Sections 56-5-3710, 56-5-3720 and 56-5-3730 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by requiring that an individual that operates a moped and any passenger to wear reflective vests. The Bill also requires that any moped sold in South Carolina be equipped with a red tail light that flashes continually while the moped is in motion and that that tail light must be turned on while the moped is being operated.
