**State Expenditure**

This bill amends Chapter 95 of Title 38 relating to the Interstate Insurance Product Regulation Compact, which expired on June 1, 2014. The bill reenacts the provisions of Act 339 of 2008 codified in Chapter 95 retroactive to the expiration date. However, the bill specifically excludes the reporting requirements and the expiration provision from reenactment.
