BILL SUMMARY:

House Bill 5014 amends Section 56-1-2100 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, as it relates to Commercial Driver's License by deleting the various endorsements and restrictions that may be attached to a commercial drives license, but also that may be added to the commercial driver's license as part of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations.
