BILL SUMMARY:

House Bill 5065 amends Section 40-30-110 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to qualifications for licensure as a massage/bodywork therapist, so as to revise the requirement of a high school diploma or its equivalent to instead require at least a tenth grade education or its equivalent.
