BILL SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 3 amends the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to certain gambling devices prohibited by Section 12-21-2710 are still prohibited even if a person holds a bingo license. Also, the legislation clarifies that these gambling devices are still prohibited in game promotions allowed by holders of permits authorizing the sale of beer or wine.
