BILL SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 76 amends the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by adding Section 40-57-247, so as to require that real estate brokers, and certain related professions, carry errors and omissions insurance. The Bill also requires the Department of Labor, Licensing and Regulation to contract with an insurance provider to obtain a group policy, and to authorize the Department to set forth the standards of a qualifying insurance policy.
