**BILL SUMMARY:**

Senate Bill 92 amends the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, to enact the “NDAA Nullification Act of 2013” by adding Section 8-1-15 relating to public officers and employees. The proposed Bill prohibits any officer or employee of the State or any officer or employee of a political subdivision from aiding the detention of any United States citizen without trial by the U. S. Armed Forces in violation of the Constitution of South Carolina.
