BILL SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 173 is a Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to the Constitution of South Carolina, 1895, to provide that the Adjutant General must be appointed by the Governor upon the advice and consent of the Senate. The proposed amendment must be submitted to the qualified electors at the next general election.

EXPLANATION OF IMPACT:

The State Election Commission indicates that this Bill would require a referendum on the ballot which would be a minimal cost that would be covered by current election funding.
