BILL SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 308 amends Section 16-23-465 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by reducing the penalties for the violation of carrying a concealed weapon to a business that sales alcohol for consumption on the business premises, but which has posted notification that the business prohibits the carry of concealed weapons.

EXPLANATION OF IMPACT:
