**BILL SUMMARY:**

Senate Bill 330 proposes to amend the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, to provide that the regular annual session of the General Assembly adjourns the first Thursday in May.

**EXPLANATION OF IMPACT:**

The House of Representatives reports that this Bill would result in a savings to the General Fund of approximately \$312,000. Additionally, the Senate indicates a General Fund savings of approximately \$112,082.
