Senate Bill 0371 amends Section 40-33-110 relating to grounds for disciplining licensed nurses by adding that if the Board of Nursing finds that a licensed nurse misreads the physician's order and over-medicates or under-medicates a patient, the Board shall revoke the nurse's license to practice in this State.
