Explanation of Amendment by Senate March 19, 2015 State Expenditure

The amended bill allows an active member of the South Carolina Retirement System or the South Carolina Police Officers Retirement System, who is terminated within one year of retirement eligibility, five business days after termination to purchase service credit pursuant to the existing terms and conditions of those systems.

The Public Employee Benefits Authority indicates that this bill, as amended, would have no expenditure impact on the General Fund, Federal Funds, or Other Funds since members are required to purchase service time at actuarial cost.

Explanation of Bill filed January 28, 2015

This bill would amend Section 8-11-620 to provide that any public employee who is terminated within one year of retirement eligibility will have five days after termination to purchase the remaining service time in order to attain retirement eligibility
