BILL SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 412 amends Section 8-13-1308 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to the contents of certified campaign reports of candidates and committees, and to amend Section 8-13-1309, relating to the contents of certified campaign reports of ballot measure committees. The Bill requires a candidate, committee, or ballot measure committee to electronically report during the twenty day period prior to an election, the receipt of a contribution from a person that exceeds two hundred fifty dollars by a single contribution or when combined with all other contributions made during the period.

EXPLANATION OF IMPACT:

The South Carolina Ethics Commission estimates this Bill will have no fiscal impact on the State General Fund or on Federal and/or Other Funds.
