## **BILL SUMMARY:**

Senate Bill 472 amends Chapter 1, Title 59 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by adding a provision requiring that no public institution of higher learning take any action or enforce any policy that would deny a religious student association benefits available to any other student association based on the religious student association's requirement of participants' adherence to religious beliefs or standards of conduct. The provision would be applicable to all public colleges and universities.

## **EXPLANATION OF IMPACT:**

Based on the colleges' and universities' individual responses to the Commission on Higher Education survey, it was determined that the provision would have no to minimal impact and any additional costs could be absorbed within existing resources.
