BILL SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 611 amends the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by adding Section 1-31-60, so as to require that the Commission for Minority Affairs eliminate eligibility for a Native American Indian group to receive official recognized status in this State and to repeal any regulations providing for recognition as a Native American Indian group. The Bill also requires that the Commission for Minority Affairs revise any of its regulations to delete any references or eliminate any procedures for recognizing a Native American group.
