BILL SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 810 amends the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, to create the College and University Trustee Screening Commission. The Commission must be composed of four members of the Senate appointed by the President Pro Tempore and four members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker.

EXPLANATION OF IMPACT:

The Senate and House of Representatives

The Clerks of both houses report that the cost per meeting for the 8 members is estimated at \$1,400 which includes per diem and subsistence. Additionally, mileage costs would be determined by the distance each member travels.
