Senate Bill 813 amends the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, to provide a person who, without legal cause or good excuse, enters a public library after having been warned by an employee, agent, or representative of the library not to do so, fails or refuses to leave immediately upon being ordered or requested to do so is guilty of a misdemeanor triable in magistrate or municipal court.
