**BILL SUMMARY:**

Senate Bill 817 amends the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by adding Section 23-3-47 which would require any individual that seeks a position or who volunteers with the Commission on National and Community Service to have a state and national criminal background check performed.

**EXPLANATION OF IMPACT:**

State Law Enforcement Division

The Division indicates that this Bill will have a minimal impact on the General Fund of the State, which the agency can absorb. The Agency will use the \$8 fee to off-set any additional costs for supplies associated with these new background checks.
