## **BILL SUMMARY:**

Senate Bill 894 amends Chapter 1 of Title 14 of the Code of Law of South Carolina, 1976, by adding Section14-1-240 which allows that a \$5 surcharge be added to all Fines, Forfeitures, Escheatment's, or Other monetary penalties imposed in the General Sessions or Magistrates or Municipal courts for misdemeanor traffic offenses or for no-traffic violations in order to fund the training at the South Carolina Criminal Justice Academy.

## **EXPLANATION OF IMPACT:**

The Law Enforcement Training Council indicates that this Bill will have no impact on the agency. This Bill codifies Proviso 118.5 of the FY 2013-14 Appropriation Act. This proviso has been in the Appropriations Act for the past several years.
