This Bill amends Section 59-63-100, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to the participation of home school students and Governor's School students in the interscholastic activities of a public school district in certain circumstances, so as to redefine the term "Home School Student" and to delete a requirement that student provide written notice of his/her intent to participate in an interscholastic activity in a school district to the Superintendent of the district before the beginning date of the season for the activity.
