Fiscal Impact Summary

This bill requires that the architectural member of the SC Building Codes Council, within the Department of Labor, Licensing and Regulation (LLR), must be chosen by the Governor from a list of qualified candidates submitted from the SC Chapter of the American Institute of Architects (AIA). LLR does not anticipate any fiscal impact, as it is expected that this bill will not materially alter their responsibilities.

Explanation of Fiscal Impact

Introduced on December 7, 2021

State Expenditure

This bill amends the appointment criteria for the member of the SC Building Codes Council, within LLR, who is a licensed architect in the state. The member must be chosen from a list of qualified candidates submitted to the Governor by the SC Chapter of the AIA. According to LLR, this bill does not impact the roles of their agency, and consequently, they do not anticipate any change in responsibilities. Therefore, LLR does not expect the bill to have an expenditure impact.
