State Expenditure

This bill amends Section 42-3-20, which states that the Governor may reappoint a person as chairman of the Workers' Compensation Commission. Also, if the Governor does not reappoint

a chairman at the end of the two year term, a majority of the commission may elect an interim chairman from their members who will serve until the Governor appoints another chairman.
