This bill is expected to shift local fire service expenditures and property tax revenue from Georgetown and Horry Counties to the Murrell's Inlet-Garden City Fire District.

Local Expenditure and Local Revenue

The bill revises the official boundaries of the Murrell's Inlet-Garden City Fire District in Georgetown and Horry Counties to reflect the most recent official map of the area designated as document F-43-51-16. The bill also deletes Section 4-23-15 that designated the official map as document F-43-51-15. The change takes effect for tax year 2016. The revised map provides additional boundary clarifications and increases the land area of the fire district. This bill is expected to shift local expenditures and property tax revenue for fire service from the originating county to the fire district. Overall, the shift in local property tax revenue will depend upon the assessed value of the property and difference in the millage rate between the originating fire service provider and the fire district.
